


Jack M. Schmitt

Sept. 6, 1941, to March 29, 2003

Jack M. Schmitt, 61, a native of Colo, died suddenly March 29 in Kaohsiung, Taiwan, where he was directing E2 programs on behalf of the United States Navy and Information Spectrum, Inc., of Washington, D.C. His work was in coordination with the Taiwan Air Force.

He was born Sept. 6, 1941, in Colo, and graduated from Colo High

School in 1959. He graduated from St. Ambrose College in Davenport in 1967.

Survivors include his wife, Karen, formerly of Rock Island, Ill.; a daughter, Kathrine Simon of Plymouth, Minn.; two sons, Brandon of Taichung, Taiwan, and Nicholas of Seattle, Wash.; three grandchildren; and two sisters, Fran Johnson of Chicago, Ill., and Joann Henle of Toledo.

Schmitt will receive full military honors on May 7 at 3 p.m. in burial at Arlington National Cemetery.
