Services for Wilbur E. Secor, 85, of Melbourne who died in his home Saturday morning were held Tuesday, 10 a.m., at St. John's United Church of Christ, with the Rev. Keith Selberg officiating. Burial followed at Melbourne Cemetery.

Mr. Secor was born May 3, 1895, in Melbourne, the son of William S. and Anna Hanson. He married Louise M. Gray September 15, 1921, in Newton.

Surviving, besides his wife, are his daughter, Mrs. M. F. (Esther) Wilson of Cedar Rapids, 11 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, one daughter, four brothers and three sisters.

Mr. Secor was raised and educated in Melbourne graduating from Marshalltown High School in 1912. He spent most of his adult life on the farm of his birth, retiring in 1966. He was an army veteran of World War I, member of St. John's church, the American Legion, the Farm Bureau and the Melbourne 50 Plus Club.
