Richard Dean Sesker, 72, died Thursday, Aug. 7, 2008, at his home near Dexter, of complications from diabetes and heart disease. Memorial services will be at 11 a.m. Monday, Aug. 11, at the Bacon Funeral Home in Maxwell. Luncheon will follow at the Maxwell Area Community Center. Inurnment will be at 2 p.m. Monday, Aug. 11, at the Cambridge Cemetery.

Richard Dean Sesker was born March 9, 1936, near Cambridge, to Tolferd E. and Alma (Adams) Sesker. Rich grew up in the Maxwell/Cambridge area, graduating from Maxwell High School in 1955.
