Dead At Age 69

STATE CENTER — (Special) — William C. Severidt, 69, a life long resident of this community, died Tuesday afternoon at Stone's Nursing Home where he had been a patient for a month. He had been in failing health for 2½ years.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday at Trinity Lutheran Church with the Rev. K. J. Baumgart in charge. Burial will be in Hillside Cemetery.

MR. SEVERIDT was born in State Center March 21, 1887 the son of William and Wilhelmina Riemenschneider Severidt. He was educated in St. Paul's parochial school and the public schools.

On April 3, 1912 he was married to Amanda Damman at State Center and she died in May 1926. Mr. Severidt was a farmer until he retired and moved to town in 1943.

HIS SECOND marriage was to Mrs. Minnie Armbrecht on Jan. 1, 1946 and she died in May this year. A half-sister also preceded him in death.

Surviving are six children, Mrs. Harold Mahlow, Glen, George, Earl and Donald, all of State Center, and Harold of Marshalltown. One sister, Mrs. Emma Pfantz of State Center; two step-daughters, Mrs. Darwin Riese of State Center, and Mrs. Melvin Mueller of Elmhurst, Ill.; 14 grandchildren and 12 step grandchildren also survive.
