Beulah Dorothy (Wampler) Severson, 94, of Nevada, died Thursday, Feb. 10, 2005, at Rolling Green Village in Nevada. Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Monday, Feb. 14, at the Chet Ryan Mortuary in Nevada with Pastor David R. Burling officiating. Burial will follow in the Radcliffe Cemetery in Radcliffe.

Beulah was born on Aug. 3, 1910, in Colo, the daughter of Orville and Blanch (Cook) Wampler. She attended Colo and graduated from Bayard High School. In 1933, she graduated from Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines as a registered nurse. She then nursed in

Albuquerque, N.M., Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines and Nevada Story County Hospital. On March 14, 1936, she married Arnold Burton Severson in Lincoln, Neb. They started Am's Dairy, distributing milk and cream throughout the Radcliffe area for 10 years. Then they purchased a grocery store in Rhodes. Later they moved back to Radcliffe and engaged in farming for 17 years. After they quit farming in 1964, they resided in Nevada until Dec. 4, 1995, when Beulah entered Rolling Green Village. Beulah was in charge of the Meals on Wheels in Story County for a period of her retirement. Some of her hobbies were sewing, crocheting, watching her grandchildren grow and spending time with her family. She was a member of Our Saviors Lutheran Church in Radcliffe and also a member of the Memorial Lutheran Church in Nevada.
