Chester Shook, 74

Chester LeeRoy Shook, 74 of Nevada died of cardiac arrest on Sunday, August 25 at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines. Funeral services will be held on Thursday, August 29 at 2:00 P.M. at the United Methodist Church in Colo with Pastor Lee Williamson officiating. Burial with military rites will follow in the Colo Cemetery.

Chester was born on January 3, 1928 in Healing Springs, Arkansas to Theodore C. and Bernice B. (Angland) Shook. He served in the U.S. Navy during W. W. II as a Seaman 1st Class.
