Obituary of James W. Shuey

James W. Shuey son of Henry and Lucretia Shuey was born at Warfieldburg, Carroll Co. Maryland, April 3, 1852. He died at his home April 18, 1918 age 66 years. He came to Sycamore, Illinois in 1870 and was married to Mary M. Middleton on April 5 1879. The family moved to Collins, Iowa in the spring of 1887.

He leaves to mourn the loss his wife, one daughter Jennie, two grand children Mabel and Winfred Torry. Three brothers Sammuel of Westminster, Maryland; Theodore of Dawson, North Dakota and John of Collins, and a host of sympathetic friends.
