MRS. IDA MARKS DIED AT PERRY, MARCH 12

d. 3-12-1933

Funeral rites were held Tuesday, March 14, at Perry for Mrs. Ida A. Marks, who died at her home there on Sunday. The rites were in charge of Warren Hile, pastor of the Church of Christ.

Music was furnished by a duo composed of Mrs. Chas. Cornelius and Mrs. John Canutt, accompanied at the piano by Mrs. Earl Keenan. They sang: "In the Garden," "The Church in the Wildwood" and "Going Down the Valley."

Casket bearers were grandsons of Mrs. Marks. They included: Clinton Cross, Eston Cross, Lee Lones, James Cross, Lloyd Edwards, James Wheeler. Interment was in the Violet Hill cemetery. The following obituary was read:

Ida Almira Skinner was born April 26, 1860, in Jasper county Iowa. She was united in marriage December 5, 1875, to Jas. Marcus Edwards. To this union were born 9 children: Charles Arthur Edwards of Morton, Idaho; Milton Medford Edwards (deceased), Lytle LeRoy Edwards of Monroe, Ia.; Albert Vernon Edwards (died in infancy) Eva Estella Cross of Perry, Ia.; Bessie May Lones of Perry, Ia.; Harry Edwards (deceased); Willis Walter Edwards of Sagle, Idaho, and Helen Amilda Wheeler. Mr. Edwards preceded her in death, Jan. 8, 1908.

After that time she moved from Jasper county to Perry with the three youngest children. Through her work as a practical nurse she became well known and loved as "Aunty" Edwards.

December 19, 1921, Mrs. Edwards was married to Henry Marks. Besides Mr. Marks and her children, she leaves to mourn her going, 27 grandchildren, 15 great grandchildren, and Mr. Marks' ten children and their families.
