Eva Blanche Carver, 90, former resident of Collins and Nevada, died at the Hill Haven Convalescent Center in Des Moines on Sunday, Dec. 18, 1983.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 20 at the Ryan Funeral Home with Rev. Ernest Smith officiating. Burial will be at the Evergreen Cemetery in Collins.

Eva Smith was born to David and Victoria (Bates) Smith on March 20, 1893 in Collins. She married William H. Carver on September 17, 1914 in Collins. William Carver died in December 1964.

She was a homemaker, and had lived in Collins and Nevada before entering the nursing home in Des Moines. She was a member of the Collins United Methodist Church.

She is survived by one son, Floyd Carver of Storm Lake; one daughter, Coleen Halbfass of Des Moines; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by three brothers and one sister.
