H. Richard "Dick" Sorensen, 82, of Nevada, died of cancer on Monday, Oct. 22, at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames.

He was born May 22, 1919, in rural Nevada to Harry and Hannah (Hanson) Sorensen. He was a graduate of Milford High School and attended lowa State University. He served in the Army during World War II and married Ellen Dwight on Aug. 10, 1947, in Nevada. He was a farmer and a member of Memorial Lutheran Church, VFW, American Legion Post #48 in Nevada, Moose Lodge in Ames and National Trappers Association and the NRA. He was a lifelong resident of Nevada and enjoyed hunting, fishing and trapping.

Funeral services were held today, Oct. 25, at 2 p.m. at Memorial Lutheran Church in Nevada with Pastor Myron D. Herzberg officiating.
