Ethlyn Stahlman, 105, of Nevada, died at Rolling Green Village in Nevada on Wednesday, June 23, 2004. Funeral services were held on Saturday, June 26, 2004 at 11:00 A.M. at the First United Methodist Church in Nevada with Pastor Steve Williams officiating. Burial followed at Nevada Municipal Cemetery in Nevada.

Ethlyn Stahlman was born on October 3, 1898 to Turner H. and Ella May (Whiteman) Lock in Gridley, Illinois. She lived in Nevada, Story County most of her life. She married Harvey L.
