Maxine B. Stratton, 60, of Hudson, IA died Saturday, June 4, 2005 at Allen Hospital in Waterloo, IA from complications of lung cancer.

Maxine was born October 13, 1944 in Story County Iowa the daughter of Haaken and Elizabeth Horness. She married Gary J. Stratton on June 12, 1965. She attended Milford Township School and graduated from Nevada High School in 1962. In 1981 she received certification as an EMT-A and was one of the first two women to join the Hudson Fire Department as a firefighter/EMT.
