W.C. Stumme dies in Elgin hospital July 29, 1937 State Center Enterprise

William C. Stumme, 63 years of age, of Great Falls Mont., passed away at an Elgin, Ill., hospital on Sunday, July 18. Mr. Stumme was in Elgin on a visit with relatives, and had stopped at Boone and State Center on the trip to Elgin, visiting relatives in both places. He was for many years a resident of Elgin, but in recent years had been employed in the Great Falls postoffice.

Mr. Stumme was born at Elk Grove, Ill., on Feb. 15, 1874. He was a member of Elgin Company. E in the Spanish war and had experienced three years army service in the Philippines. He was married to Emma Leininger of Boone, Iowa, and for a time they made their home in State Center, later moving to Great Falls, Mont.
