An accomplished artist, she was active in her church, had been a youth leader and worked along side her husband in the family's lumberyard. She enjoyed painting, reading, bird watching, growing things and family activities. She loved her home along the Cedar River.

Survivors include her husband, Carrol D. Callison; three sons: Wesley (and Patty) of Jacksonville, Fla., Terry (and Sandra) of Fridley, Minn., Steve (and Rose) of Norway,

Iowa; two sisters, Marion Ferguson and Kathryn French, both of Maxwell; seven grandchildren; two step-grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; one step great-grandchild; and a beloved ex-daughter-in-law, Jeannie Callison.

Preceding her in death were her parents, five siblings and an infant grandson.
