Funeral services for Mrs. Guy Eastman, 212 East State street, who died Thursday at the Deaconess hospital, were held at 1:30 p. m. Saturday at the Ralph Thorton home southwest of State Center and at 2 o'clock at the Methodist church at Rhodes in charge of Rev. P. G. Dennis of Marshalltown. Burial was in Eden cemetery at Rhodes.
