Everett Russell Vannorsdel, 85, of Nevada, died of a stroke on Monday, Dec. 3, at Story County Medical Center in Nevada.

He was born Sept. 17, 1916, in Kingsley to Roy and Emma (Ray Vannorsdel. He married Gloria Bramson on April 30, 1943, at Lone Rock. He was owner of Man-An-So and a member of Missouri Sheriff's Association, Rotary, past president of National Columbia Sheep Association and founding board member of White Park Cattle Association. He loved cars, cattle and sheep, sports and nutrition and had been a resident of Nevada for 35 years.

Survivors include his wife, Gloria, of Nevada; two sons, Gary (and Martha) of Kansas City, Mo., and Monte (and Patricia) of Boone; two daughters, Vicki (and Gary) Stutzman of Ames and Toni (and David) Lenning of Nevada; eight grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and two sisters, Sylvia Yingst of Centerville, Ohio, and Vesta Tilbury of Nevada.
