Norma Jones Villont, 74

Norma (Gerry) Villont was born Sept. 4, 1927 in Rhodeſ, the daughter of Hubert Drumond and Sadie Edith (Fuller) Jones. She was raised in State Center, where she attended school and later continued her education at Iowa State Teachers College and Drake University. On Nov. 27, 1946 she married Clarence Villont.
