Karroll H. Vinsel, 88, of Zearing, died of pneumonia Monday, Feb. 18, at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames.

He was born Feb. 9, 1914, in Zearing to Roy Charles and Blanche (Holcomb) Vinsel. He remained a lifelong resident of Zearing. He married Ruth Nelson on June 12, 1947, at the E.U.B. Church in Zearing. He served as a meat inspector for the Army during World War II. He was a lab worker at the N.A.C.D. in Ames, retiring in December of 1982. He was a member of the Bethel United Methodist Church in Zearing and a 50-year member of Zearing American Legion Post No. 116.

Survivors include his wife, Ruth of Zearing; a son, Dennis Vinsel of Guam; two daughters, Karilyn De Ann Vinsel of Alden and Vicky Lynn Vinsel of Ames; and a grandson.

His parents, two brothers, Kenneth and Clement, and a sister, Amelia, preceded him in death.
