NEVADA - Nina Marie Koehler, 94, of Nevada died July 25, 2004 at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were held Wednesday at the Nevada Assembly of God Church with Rev. Tom Poppe officiating. Burial was in the Nevada Municipal Cemetery.

She was born April 22, 1910 in Clyde, North Dakota, the daughter of Charles Wesley and Effie (Strickler) Walker. She was united in marriage to Homer L. Wilson on January 1, 1930. Homer died in January of 1937. Nina later married Herbert Edward Koehler in October of 1940. Herbert died April 22, 1983. Nina retired from working at Iowa State College in 1972. She was a member of the Nevada Assembly of God Church.
