## Walker Dies *June 2-75* At 100; Rites To Be Thursday

NEVADA — (Special) — Charles Wesley Walker of Nevada, 100 years old, died Tuesday at the hospital in Nevada, where he had been for a number of years. He was former resident of Rhodes and a brother-in-law of Mrs. Nina Baker 309 E. State St., Marshalltown.

Services will be Thursday at 2 p.m. at the Assembly of God Church with burial in the Nevada cemetery.

Mr. Walker was born March 29, 1875, at Ashton, Ill., and moved with his parents to Marshall County when he was a young boy. He homesteaded near Clyde, N.D. as a young man. On March 14, 1907, he was married at Marshalltown to Effie Strickler of Rhodes. They lived near Clyde until 1912, when they returned to Rhodes, where they made their home for many years before moving to Nevada. His wife and two daughters preceded him in death.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Herbert (Nina) Koehler of Nevada; one son, Charles J. Walker of Cambridge; seven grandchildren and a number of great grandchildren.
