Obituary

Fanny Jane Wilson was born Oct. 6, 1839 and died Feb. 26, 1912. Her birth place was Muskingum county, Ohio. She moved with her parents to Gallia county, Ohio, when three years old. At the age of fourteen she moved with them to Mechanicsville, Cedar county, Iowa. She married J. A. Morrison there in 1858. They moved from Cedar county to Story county, locating north of Collins in 1882, living there until about 1895 when they moved to the farm where she passed away. To

this union were born twelve children, five of whom survive, viz: Mrs. Sarah Mills of McCallsburg, Mrs. Lydia Robinson of Rhodes, Frank W. of Rhodes, Fred of Sedalia, Mo., and Charles A. of Rhodes, Iowa. Three sisters and four brothers survive her, viz: Mrs. Boyles Jackson of Mechanicsville, Mrs. Ed Bowers of Payton, Mrs. Albert Boyles of Sutherland, S. H. Wilson of Mechanicsville, Wm. Wilson of Anita, Jas. H. Wilson of Muscatine, and Alexander Wilson of Pawnee, Okl.

She died at her home near Rhodes at 11:30 p. m. Feb. 26, 1912, aged 72 years, 4 months, 20 days.

The funeral was at the M. E. church of Rhodes last Thursday. The pastor, Rev. J. W. Parks, preached a sympathetic sermon to a large congregation of neighbors and friends.

The interment was at the Rhodes Cemetery beside the grave of her husband.
