Dean Wolf, 74, formerly of Collins, now of southern California, died Oct. 28 at the Story Medical Center in Nevada.

He was born Aug. 10, 1929, in Maxwell to Arley and Ethel (Dunahoo) Wolf. He married Carolyn Partridge on Oct. 10, 1948, in the Peoria United Methodist Church near Maxwell. He was an Army Veteran of WWII. He had been a cabinet maker while living in the Collins area. After retirement, Carolyn and Dean, became avid "RV'ers" and enjoyed traveling. They had been in all 50 states, but Rhode Island. Dean had been a little league baseball coach, a former member of the Beaumont Police Reserve. He enjoyed woodworking.
