

John Zahnd Dies Monday

MELBOURNE — Funeral services for John L. Zahnd, 46, rural Melbourne, who died Monday, Dec. 6 at his home, will be held at 2:30 p.m. today, Thursday, at the Pursel-Davis Chapel in Marshalltown.

The Rev. Curt Anderson will be in charge and burial will be at Riverside Cemetery, Marshalltown. Pallbearers will be Max Nason, John Soorholtz, Carroll Paul, Vernon Gallentine, Robert Fouch and Edwin Harsha.
