

**557. MARSHALLTOWN AND
LINN TOWNSHIP.**

GLICK, GEORGE, President of the First National Bank ; born in Germany March 18, 1827 ; came to America, located in Mansfield, Ohio, and lived there until 1849 ; removed to Indiana, and in the Spring of 1850, went across the plains to California ; was there five years, and returned to Ohio in 1855, and came to Marshalltown, Iowa, in 1856 ; engaged in the dry goods and grocery trade with Mr. Rice, one of the founders of the town ; in 1858, he engaged in the drug business, and continued until 1870, when he engaged in the banking business ; has been Director of the First National Bank since it was organized in 1864, and has been President for the past five years. Has held the office of Postmaster and town offices. Married Miss Jane Ziegenfelder, from Pickaway, Ohio, November 1, 1855 ; they have five children—Charles, Alice, Albert G., Frank and Fred.
